Palm Spring Animal Shelter Live Release Rate (LRR): LRR is a meaningful parameter to indicate a community's progress toward improving outcomes for its animals. LRR is calculated by dividing the number of animals that enter PSAS alive less those who die or are euthanized (or are lost), by the total number of live animals received. PSAS tracks LRR for cats only, dogs only, other animals only, and combined. This is the method previously required for reporting to Rest Friends Animal Society and does not include TNR numbers.

* Note: The lower LRR for "Other" animals is largely due to sick/injured wildlife brought to the shelter. Of the 34 "Other" animals that died or were euthanized, all were wildlife.

TNR Cats: All 307 TNR cats with intakes during the 2nd quarter also had outcomes during the 2nd quarter

Cats Trapped But Kept: The difference between intakes and outcomes for this category is because: 22 cats with intakes during this time period were still in the shelter on 6/30/22, 16 cats with outcomes during this time period arrived at the shelter prior to 4/1/22. [81-22 still in shelter + 16 with older intakes = 75 outcomes]

Cats SNR: The difference between intakes and outcomes for this category is because: 1 cat/s with outcomes during this time period arrived at the shelter prior to 4/1/22. [3+ 1 with older intakes = 4 outcomes]
